

CHILD VACCINATIONS

SCREENING SCHEDULE

Your child changes at an amazing rate. It's important to keep them up-to-date on immunizations and schedule regular check-ups to monitor their development. Take an active role in your healthcare, and that of your family, and stay on top of routine screening and immunization needs. Consult with your family physician or pediatrician for special circumstances, or to make a catch-up plan if your child's vaccination schedule is a month or more behind.

NOTE: Each block represents one recommended dose. Example: Hepatitis B requires three doses; one at birth, one at two months and one between nine and 12 months.
